

AFTER YOUR CROWN PREPARATION

- A temporary crown made of plastic has been placed on your tooth.
- Direct chewing on the temporary crown should be avoided.
- If your temporary comes off or becomes loose, call to have it recemented. Leaving your temporary off could cause complications when we try to cement your permanent crown.
- It is normal to experience some discomfort after your crown preparation, such as soreness around the gumline or sensitivity to cold. Some degree of this sensitivity could last the entire time the temporary crown is in place.

Noticeable swelling or constant pain is something we should know about. It is not normal to experience severe pain when pressure is applied to the tooth or to experience swollen painful gums.
